### 1. Preliminary Matters

#### 1.1 Call to Order

Lori Pullman called the meeting to order at 3:07pm

### 1.2 Approval of the Agenda

#### 1.3 Approval of the Minutes

Mark Hamamura and Manoj Wickremesinghe noted corrections to be made to the minutes.

# Amendments to the 12/06/23 minutes:

#### 2. General Discussion

### 2.1 Accreditation Technical Review

Anna Hanlon and Sheri Sterner gave a presentation that discussed the Orientation to ISER Technical Review Process.

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The new ISER standards from the ACCIC, have shifted from focusing on asking the college to describing processes to asking the college to provide outcomes and areas for improvement. There is also greater emphasis on equity and inclusion, in efforts to close performance gaps.

Anna explained the content needed to explain our processes to the ACCJC. The deadline for the campus-wide final report of our standards is by Spring 2025. Anna reminded the committee to review the standards and asked for active participation in the review process.

#### 2.2 Articulation update

Manoj Wickremesinghe updated the committee that there will be a new Title V change for local degrees. The state allowed the colleges to have an extra year to make these changes effective Fall 2025.

The deadline to post the catalog is June 1. Lori Pullman will meet the chairs in March, to discuss planning for these changes. Lori anticipates that the local unit requirement GE will change for the Ethnic Studies area, effective Fall 2024. The remaining GE requirement changes will be effective Fall 2025. She will follow up with the committee after she meets with the chairs.

Lori discussed the proposed language that was approved to be added for Math A010, Math A030, and ENG A099/ESL A099. These were approved on the 11/15/23 Voting Meeting.

- Math A010 prerequisite language: "Course taught at the level of elementary algebra or higher or appropriate math placement (based on high school GPA and/or other measures)."
- Math A030 language: "Course taught at the level of intermediate algebra or higher or appropriate math placement (based on high school GPA and/or other measures)."
- ENGL A099 or ESL A099 prerequisite language: "Enrollment requires appropriate placement (based on high school GPA and/or other measures) or eligibility for college composition."

Lori and Elizabeth Page received confirmation from Manoj to send out these notes for the associated disciplines and Departments, to add to the course content.

Mark Hamamura addressed the need to discuss the unit alignments for the English courses. Lori stressed the need for the Articulation Officers to meet with the English department and Math department, to work a way to get these courses and programs aligned to comply with state degree unit limits.

#### 2.3 Curriculum Specialist Update

Elizabeth Page notified the assembly the college will be going live with Courseleaf CIM beginning Fall 2025 semester. There will be a shutdown period after the Spring 2025 semester. The summer 2025 period will be used for technical testing. Elizabeth during the summertime, for technical testing and fixing errors.

The specialists from all three colleges in the District have formed an ad hoc group to work on mock cores to present to the chairs and committee for review. Elizabeth and Lori asked the committee to reach out to them, for any input they may have to help faculty transition into the implementation of this new software.

She also asks for input regarding the pros and cons of CurricUNET, so she can help provide the information to the CIM team.

The catalog will be launched next week.

#### **General Discussion**

Melissa Jauregui has addressed the issue with the OCC Computer Science Department not honoring the CID-approved courses from Golden West. She wanted to confirm if there has been a discussion to resolve this. Elizabeth updated the assembly that this issue is being handled by the Vice President of Instruction.
