This is to inform you that your registration appointment for the Fall 2020 semester is now available on MyCoast. Registration begins June 15th for legislated groups. Registration begins June 17th for continuing students meeting level 1 priority requirements. Please take a moment to locate your appointment and prepare for registration.

Breaking News: A new registration experience is available for you to use now on MyCoast! It is mobile friendly and offers new features! Be on the lookout for more details in the coming weeks. Go to MyCoast→Registration Tools→Add or Drop Classes, to experience this upgrade today!

Registration is done online using MyCoast on or after your scheduled appointment date/time!

More Breaking News! Beginning with **Fall 2020 Registration**, you will also be able to register on your assigned registration time for classes at the other two colleges in the Coast Community College District, Coastline College and Golden West College, without having to submit separate admissions applications.

Checks for Semester Success!

In preparation for successfully enrolling in classes, please do the following:

- ✓ **Select your classes now!** The Fall Class schedule is available now on the OCC Website (www.orangecoastcollege.edu) and on MyCoast. *Please be advised that courses with the same number and the same title may not be equivalent across the three colleges in the district, and might not be the course you need for your major, general education, or transfer path. It is your responsibility to check with Counseling at your home college to confirm that this course meets your specific educational goals.*
- ✓ **Plan your schedule!** OCC offers a schedule planning tool on MyCoast. Plan your ideal schedule at the times you are available to take classes. (Registration→Registration Tools→Schedule Planner)
- ✓ **Check for Holds!** Make sure you don't have any holds on your account (Registration Tab → Other Student Resources → Holds Information). If you have a hold, follow the appropriate steps to clear the hold early so that you will be able to register on your assigned appointment time.
- ✓ **Check for Prerequisites!** If the course in which you intend to enroll has a prerequisite, you **must** have completed the prerequisite course with a "C" or better. If you have completed the course at another college or university, submit an online "[Clearance Request Form](#)" along with a copy of the transcript. Please allow 5 days for processing your request.

- ✓ **Register on your assigned appointment time!** Check MyCoast for your registration date and time (Registration Tab → Registration Tools → Registration Status & Checklist → Prepare for Registration → Select a Term)
- ✓ **Make your choice count!** Take a seat in a class only if you're serious about the class.
- ✓ **Pay your fees!** Pay your fee balance at the time you register to avoid being dropped for non-payment.
- ✓ **Know your Drop & Refund Deadlines!** All deadline dates can be checked on your Student Class Program (Web Schedule Bill). These deadlines are mandated by the State of California. [Dates to Remember.](#)
- ✓ **Need Financial Aid?** [Apply for financial aid](#) by completing the 2020-21 FAFSA application!

Non-Payment Drops

Closed Classes: If the class in which you wish to enroll has a “closed” status you may be able to add yourself to a waitlist. Many classes have a “waitlist” option.
