

Got Pre-reqs?

If a course you're planning to enroll in has a pre-requisite, you must submit a [Pre-Requisite Clearance Request](#) along with documentation before you can register.

Have your unofficial AP Scores, HS Transcript or College Transcript ready to upload with your request.

When do I register?

Your registration date can be found in your MyCoast Portal. After logging-in, click the Registration tab on the left, then select "View My Eligibility" under the Priority Registration section.

OCC offers four general education patterns based on educational program and goal. These can be found in the OCC Catalog

- [Associate of Science \(AS\)/ Option 1](#): For OCC majors/ programs leading to the AS degree
- [Associate of Arts \(AA\)/ Option 1](#): For OCC majors/ programs leading to the AA degree
- [CSU GE Breadth/ Option 2](#): For transfer to a California State University
- [IGETC/ Option 3](#): For transfer to University of California, California State University (many private and out of state schools also accept IGETC GE)

Online: Assigned hours per week but not specific days or times

Live Online: Real-time instruction. Specific days and times to meet online
