Dear Friends of Orange Coast College:

Since 1985, the Orange Coast College Foundation has built a legacy of providing support for programs and projects that benefit OCC students. We are particularly grateful to the generous donors acknowledged in this report.

2023-24 was an outstanding year for the Orange Coast College Foundation. Our generous supporters provided 3,983 individual gifts totaling \$5,645,178 in cash gifts and donated vessels valued at \$3,295,690. The Foundation's endowment grew by 20.7% from \$29 million to \$34 million.

Significant gifts during the past year included \$904,000 for scholarships from the estates of long-time faculty members Mary McChesney and Lyn Bonin. Through a grant from the State of California, \$950,000 was received for new playground equipment for the OCC Early Childhood Education Lab School. In early 2025 a new Executive Director of the Foundation will join the College.

We would also like to extend our gratitude to the volunteer members of the Orange Coast College Foundation Board of Directors listed on page 16 for their service and support of Orange Coast College during the past year.

We hope that you enjoy reading about the new and exciting developments at Orange Coast College, many of which are made possible by the support of our many generous donors and their gifts that help us transform the lives of our students through education.

OCC PHOTOGRAPHY PROGRAM RECEIVES \$500K FOR JEFF GROSS PHOTOGRAPHY ENDOWMENT

Orange Coast College's School of Photography received a gift of \$500,000 from the William, Jeff and Jennifer Gross Foundation for the Jeff Gross Photography Endowment.

The donation will be used to help fund the purchase and repair of photography equipment for students and pay for advanced photography students to serve as tutors for their entry-level peers.

The Jeff Gross Photography Endowment was established in 2021 after the School of Photography received a \$450,000 grant from the William, Jeff and Jennifer Gross Family Foundation.

"Jeff simply was looking to give back to the medium that has given him so much over the years," says OCC photography professor Blade Gillissen. "He felt what better way to give back than to help the next generation of photographers."

The flexibility of the gift means the endowment can be spent on a range of items: new equipment,

repairing older equipment, or short-term staffing and tutoring.

"More and more, the photography program is relying on one-time funds to purchase and repair equipment and this leads to a kind of boom or bust situation," Gillissen says. "An endowment like this can provide our students with year-in and year-out consistency."

Jeff Gross is a professional photographer who graduated from the Brooks School of Photography and has worked as a staff photographer for Getty Images since 1988.

BRINGING PERIODIC TABLE OF ELEMENTS TO LIFE

When the Chemistry Building opens its doors for classes in Spring 2025, visitors will find an engaging and interactive periodic table of elements display in the lobby.

This illuminated display features individual cabinets for each element, showcasing the name, symbol and a sample of the element (no radioactive materials). The cabinets contain a fascinating array of high-grade element samples, minerals, ores and artifacts. Some of these samples are linked to Orange Coast College and its geographical location. For example, the cabinet for sodium includes rock salt from Guerrero Negro, a location where marine science students visit during their annual grey whale field trip.

Faculty and student presenters will have the ability to showcase individual elements or groups of elements using an iPad. Above the display, there will be a touchscreen that visitors can use to access short videos about each element, providing an easy way to learn more about their properties.

WAYNE WOLFE'S WAY

Faculty emeritus makes gift to start scholarship in memory of his wife

Wayne Wolfe began his career at Orange Coast College as assistant dean in admissions and records. Over time, he worked his way up the ladder until he returned to his true passion: teaching.

For over a decade, he served as a mathematics professor at OCC, earning a reputation that students fondly referred to as "Wayne Wolfe's Way." This catchy phrase encouraged students to enroll in Wolfe's algebra classes, particularly those struggling with the subject. A significant part of Wolfe's success as a professor stemmed from his use of various teaching methods.

"I had some learning difficulties when I was younger, so I understood what students were going through," Wolfe explained. "Therefore, I taught using different learning modalities. If students learned better in a specific way, I was committed to teaching it that way."

Wolfe's passion for education extended into his personal life, as his wife was also an educator who taught English and home economics. Sharon also had a passion for sewing, particularly quilting.



"My wife and I shared a wonderful life together." said Wolfe. "We were married for 59 years, and after she passed away, I dedicated a significant portion of my finances to helping students in her name. We both believed in the importance of education, so I created the Educator Sharon Wolfe Scholarship to support the next generation of teachers."

This scholarship is awarded to students who are pursuing a career in teaching and are in good academic standing.

Additionally, this year, Wolfe contributed 500 books to OCC's fashion department, ensuring that students did not have to purchase them.

"Students are the heart of our future here, and we all need to support them because they represent both our future and the future of our country." stated Wolfe.



IN PURSUIT OF **EDUCATION**

Pablo Sanchez penned thank you letters to generous donors after receiving three scholarships at OCC's annual Honors Night. He believed it was unlikely the donors would take the time to read his letter, so he decided to pour his heart into them. This gave the aspiring writer an opportunity to refine his craft.

To his surprise, the donors did read his letters. Sanchez was later called to the Scholarship Office and informed of a hold on one of his scholarships. A moment of panic set in, as he had earmarked some of those funds for a new laptop, hoping to avoid the constant need to check one out from the Library. What followed was a bit unprecedented: the donor wanted to increase his scholarship from \$1,500 to \$5,500.

Sanchez was in shock. First, he never thought anyone would actually read his letter. Second, he didn't realize his words had the power to evoke such an emotional response.

For the 43-year-old full-time student, the extra money allowed him to purchase a laptop and pay off outstanding bills. While this may not seem like much to some, for Sanchez, it alleviated a significant amount of stress and anxiety, allowing him to focus better on his studies.

"All of these things weigh on a student whether people understand it or not," explained Sanchez. "It's tough to concentrate when I'm starving. All these little things matter. So, having that money took a lot of stress away from school."

Last year, Sanchez decided to pursue higher education. It was always on his mind, but as a father of two daughters, life had gotten in the way. Now that his daughters are older, he decided to take the plunge and start his educational journey.

He quickly Googled "community college by the beach." At the time, Sanchez was living in Las Vegas and needed a change of scenery. One of the first community colleges that appeared in the



search was Orange Coast College. He packed his car and drove out to Costa Mesa.

Upon arriving at OCC, Sanchez was directed to The Hub, where he learned about next steps for enrollment. He was surprised by how invested the staff members were in his overall well-being and success, as they provided him with numerous resources available on campus.

Now in his second year, Sanchez has found community at the Garrison Honors Center, which he discovered while searching for a quiet place to study. Grateful for the generosity he has received, he is committed to paying it forward. Even though he is currently experiencing housing insecurity, he still finds the means to contribute to Pirates' Cove, OCC's on-campus food pantry.



Retired faculty member Mary McChesney will forever leave a lasting legacy at Orange Coast College.

McChesney passed away in January 2023 and taught Spanish and English Literature at OCC from 1950 through 1983. Her love for OCC was quite evident, especially when, in 2017, she made one of the most significant donations to OCC at the time to help fund the Foucault Pendulum in the OCC Planetarium.

"I have grown old, but my love for this College is very much alive," McChesney said. "Here is the promise for an exciting future."

Her gift of \$1 million was made through the Bonin/McChesney Trust. Adelyn (Lyn) Bonin was McChesney's late partner, who passed away in 2017. Bonin was an OCC faculty member from 1959 through 1983, where she taught German.

Having made the donation in honor of her late partner, McChesney said, "I know Lyn would be happy to do this. This is half hers. I like to think she sees what we are doing, and she approves."

After McChesney's passing, the OCC Foundation received a gift of \$904,000 from the trust of Mary McChesney and Lyn Bonin in July 2023.

The \$904,000 will fund endowed scholarships to benefit OCC students. Details of the scholarship are being developed by the Scholarship Committee and OCC Foundation.

"OCC is fortunate to have such dedicated faculty members, such as Mary McChesney, whose love for the College continued well past her retirement," said Doug Bennett, Executive Director of College Advancement. "Her love and legacy will support students pursuing their higher education goals."

HILGENDORF **ENDOWMENT FUNDS** ATHLETIC RENOVATIONS

A longtime faculty member, coach and administrator, Jane Hilgendorf made a lasting impact at Orange Coast College as a leader in the College's athletics program. Her legacy continues through the Jane Hilgendorf Athletics Endowment.

After Jane's passing in 2016 at the age of 74, OCC received a remarkable gift of \$1,012,500 from Hilgendorf's estate. 75 percent of this donation was allocated to the OCC Kinesiology and Athletics Department, which established the Jane Hilgendorf Athletics Endowment.

This endowment supports various athletic needs and renovations. Recent projects of two Hilgendorf Endowment include:

OCC Softball Upgrade

In 2024, a \$55,000 contribution from former OCC Athletic Director Jane Hilgendorf's trust sparked additional support from other donors and departments on campus for the growing softball team. This donation helped grow the project's total to nearly \$100,000.

The improvements include a new equipment shed, fresh paint, team room and field updates. Thankful for the gracious new additions, the Foundation's wish list includes restroom facilities and permanent seating, for which they are seeking passionate supporters of women's sports to sponsor.



Football Team Room

Located in the Doc Mason Fieldhouse, the Football Team Room has recently undergone renovations, which included new flooring, fresh paint and updated furniture. These enhancements were made possible by the Jane Hilgendorf Athletics Endowment. The improvements to the Football Team Room have fostered team bonding and increased interest from recruits visiting campus.





Gym Floor | Peterson Gymnasium

Orange Coast College's Peterson Gymnasium received a facelift, with the gym floor earning a fresh coat of paint and varnish courtesy of the Jane Hilgendorf Athletics Endowment. OCC's gym floor was dedicated in Hilgendorf's name in 2017, following her death in 2016.





More than just a few painted walls, the Orange Coast College Technology Annex has been transformed into a state-of-the-art learning environment that rivals those of four-year universities. This transformation was made possible by a generous donation from an anonymous donor, enabling OCC's Aviation Science program to create a space that fosters learning, collaboration and community.

When the College Center opened its doors in 2020, Aviation Science seized the opportunity to expand its physical space. Previously, the program shared its area with Hospitality, Travel, and Tourism, but following their relocation to the College Center, Aviation Science was able to move into the entire building.

"We were fortunate to expand into the rest of the building and make that our home base," said OCC Aviation Science Program Coordinator and instructor Stanley Harriman. "It was a dream to gain more space because space on a college campus is like gold."

Renovations to the Technology Annex included new flooring, fresh paint, upgraded LED lighting, and enhanced audio visual equipment in all classrooms.

The anonymous donor, an aviation enthusiast, recognized the urgent need to address the national pilot shortage. According to the CEO of the Regional Airline Association, the U.S. airline industry is facing a wave of pilot retirements that will exacerbate this shortage.

OCC's Aviation Science program has actively positioned itself to meet this demand, primarily by becoming certified as a Part 141 school. After three years of discussions with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), the program achieved its designation as a Part 141 flight school.

As a Part 141 flight school, OCC has demonstrated to the FAA that it maintains a structured syllabus and effective curriculum, achieving an 80 percent pass rate. This accomplishment has significantly raised the program's profile.

"It's a big deal to have graduates from a Part 141 school," Harriman noted. "People view graduates as top-notch and well-rounded in their training and education."

Additionally, the program has acquired a fullmotion jet simulator, making it one of the few colleges in California with this advanced equipment. This simulator allows students to familiarize themselves with jet procedures and better prepares them for the industry.

"For our department, the donation and expansion feel like a full circle moment," Harriman stated. "We've expanded our program with our jet simulator, and our students benefit from the experience of being part of a FAAcertified Part 141 school. Additionally, thanks to the recent renovations, we now have the appearance of a genuine Part 141 school."

A SIGHT TO BEHOLD

Telescope Farm Draws Hundreds for Great North American Eclipse Viewing Event

Hundreds descended onto Orange Coast College to peer through solar telescopes to catch a brief glimpse of the partial solar eclipse. People of all ages arrived for an opportunity to marvel and experience the Great North American Eclipse.

The solar eclipse crossed North America, passing over Mexico, the United States, and Canada, and was visible to millions on April 8, 2024. The OCC Planetarium hosted a viewing event for the public to experience this partial solar eclipse and utilized its telescope farm for this highly anticipated event.

"A solar eclipse and a lunar eclipse occur every six months," Astronomy professor Jerome Fang said. "However, a solar eclipse can only be seen in certain locations, so it is rare for people to see it in Costa Mesa. People can see a lunar eclipse more frequently than a solar eclipse because the area where a lunar eclipse can be seen is more extensive than that of a solar eclipse."

Guests of the viewing event were fortunate enough to have multiple ways of experiencing the solar eclipse, including eclipse glasses and solar telescopes.

"We set up a 230 mm solar telescope outside for the annular solar eclipse event," OCC Planetarium Manager Jessica Artinger said. "This telescope is pretty rare for a community college to have. We are able to look at the sun through this telescope and see it close up."

OCC began construction on a telescope farm in September 2022. The telescope farm includes eight telescopes that can be used by students and the public for nighttime viewing of the stars and solar observation. The project was funded by a \$1 million grant from an anonymous donor. The same grant also funded other astronomy related projects, including OCC's Astronomy House, student field trips to the Planetarium, and various telescopes used by the College's Astronomy department.





OCC WELCOMED HUNDREDS TO ORANGE **COUNTY CHILDREN'S BOOK FESTIVAL**

Orange Coast College welcomed the community to join in celebrating the 21st annual Orange County Children's Book Festival on Sunday, September 22.

Guests participated in fun, family-friendly activities such as storytelling, conversations with the featured authors, book signings, Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics (STEAM) activity area, face painting, train rides, bounce house, and photo opportunities with popular sci-fi characters.

The OCCBF's 2024 special guest authors included cartoonist and teacher Gene Luen Yang, #1 New

York Times-bestselling author of middle-grade novels Jasmine Warga, Newbery Medal-winning author Cynthia Kadohata, and actress and producer Austin Highsmith Garces.

Harry Shum Jr. and Shelby Rabara made a lastminute addition to the lineup of main stage authors. During the event, they read from their book "Martee Dares to Dance" and held a book signing.

This marks the second year the OCC Foundation has led and organized this extensive book festival for the local community.

OCC LEADER OF FUNDRAISING SCOREBOARD AMONG CALIFORNIA COMMUNITY COLLEGES

In the 2023-2024 academic year, OCC studentathletes and various college programs reached out to their friends and family, successfully raising over \$200,000 through crowdfunding campaigns supported by the OCC Foundation.

Each campaign featured a video message from students who shared their experiences at OCC and explained how donations supported their educational journey at the College.

As a result of this collective effort, OCC emerged as the leader among California community colleges in crowdfunding, raising the most money in the 2023-2024 academic year.

OCC HOMECOMING

UCLA & Georgetown alumna returns to alma mater

Chat with Lori Ginex-Orinion for a while, and you'll likely hear her mention that she served as the ASOCC President in 1995-1996 while studying at Orange Coast College. Though she now shares this experience with pride, OCC wasn't her first choice for higher education.

Despite being an honor roll student, at the top of her class, and a distinguished scholar, Lori's educational path took an unexpected turn when her mother informed her that OCC would be the school she would support financially.

Reluctantly, Ginex-Orinion enrolled for her first semester at OCC. Before starting, she applied for several scholarships and received many, including one scholarship that included a stipulation requiring her to enroll in the ASOCC class.

This requirement led to some of her fondest memories at the College.

"I loved everything we did. At the beginning of the year, we attended a leadership retreat for all the student leaders and club presidents. It was so rewarding to

be involved with activities on campus," Ginex-Orinion recalled.

Moving On Up

After two years at OCC, Ginex-Orinion transferred to UCLA to major in political science, graduating within two years. After taking a one-year break, she enrolled in Georgetown Law, one of the most prestigious law schools in the nation.

"I love to tell people that I attended OCC, UCLA, and then Georgetown for law school because it reassures them that my education is legitimate, not just a backup plan," she explained.

After graduating from Georgetown Law, she began her career at a Big Four law firm and later became Of Counsel at a boutique firm. Today, she is the founding and co-managing partner of Aviso Legal Group, LLP, which she established in 2017 with a colleague.

Back to Roots

Years later, an unexpected email from a familiar name reignited her interest in OCC. Doug Bennett,

> the Executive Director of the OCC Foundation, reached out to Ginex-Orinion to seek her legal expertise.

Not long after, a position on the Foundation Board became available, and she stepped into the role. Now, Ginex-Orinion is directly involved with upcoming projects at the College, in a somewhat similar capacity to her time as ASOCC President.

"I just enjoy hearing about the College's initiatives and figuring out how we can encourage growth in any way possible," she said. "I love that OCC levels the playing field for everyone. It provides great access to quality education for all."

OCC FOUNDATION/ FINANCIAL OVERVIEW

Total audited gifts and pledges to the Orange Coast College Foundation for the 2023-24 year were \$9,155,526. Cash gifts totaled \$5,645,178 and gifts of boats and equipment were valued at \$3,510,348.

The total audited assets of the OCC Foundation were valued at \$48,565,449 million as of June 30, 2024. Cash held for scholarships, short term projects and programs, and operating stood at \$5,645178.

The value of the Foundation's endowment stood at \$33,927,168 as of June 30, 2024.

The OCC Foundation endowment assets are managed by Northern Trust Bank and for the year ending June 30, 2024 earned 14.34%% net of fees. Since inception in 2012 the Northern Fund has earned 7.11% net of fees.

DIRECTED SCHOLARSHIPS

Over the last ten years, the Orange Coast College Foundation has awarded over \$7.2 million in scholarships to new, continuing, and transferring students.

OCC Foundation scholarships recognize academic achievement, leadership, and community service by new, continuing, and transferring OCC students.

In 2023-24 the Foundation awarded \$801,118 in scholarships. At the 2024 Honors Night Program,

422 individual students were awarded 578 scholarships totaling \$769,050. Local high school students received \$13,300 in scholarships for the Fall 2024.

The Foundation administers a wide range of scholarships from outside organizations, service clubs and state programs. From January 1, 2024 – October 31, 2024, 513 outside scholarships were awarded totaling \$454,521.



Doug Bennett, the first-ever Executive Director of the Orange Coast College Foundation, is retiring after nearly four decades of dedicated service.

For Doug Bennett, the role of Executive Director of the OCC Foundation is more than just a job – it's a mission to transform lives. As the driving force behind the OCC Foundation, Bennett has been the vital link between the College's aspirations and the community's generosity. He has steadily guided the growth and development of the Foundation while raising millions of dollars for student scholarships, programs and special projects.

Bennett began his career at OCC in early 1986. Before joining Coast, he worked in the fundraising office at St. Joseph Hospital and thought he would only be at the College for a few years. Little did he know that he would remain for nearly four decades.

Affectionately known as Mr. OCC, Bennett embodies the school spirit of Orange Coast College. His love and enthusiasm for the College are palpable. You can often find him wearing OCC gear, attending athletics games, participating in campus events and sharing his extensive institutional knowledge.

His first major campaign was in 1989, successfully remodeling the Robert B. Moore Theatre, which included significant improvements like air conditioning and upgraded acoustics.

"Back then, some people didn't really understand why I was hired and what my role was, but when they saw what we were able to achieve with the Moore Theatre, it gave us credibility because we were successful," Bennett explained.

Since then, under his leadership, the Foundation has raised millions of dollars for scholarships, grants and capital projects. However, it's not solely about the money; it's about fostering a community of support. Bennett works tirelessly to cultivate relationships that benefit both the College and the broader community.

Bennett's achievements range from securing donations of boats and equipment to million-dollar gifts, even an island in Canada. Yet, his proudest moment was securing a grant to support foster youth at the College, which eventually evolved into the Guardian Scholars program we see today.

"For me, it's crucial to focus on how our work helps students and how the gifts people make change student lives," he stated.
