# OCC Respiratory Care program recognized by CoARC

Orange Coast College's Respiratory Care program has been chosen to receive a Distinguished Registered Respiratory Therapist Credentialing Success Award by the Commission on Accreditation for Respiratory Care (CoARC).

This award recognizes the OCC program's success in achieving at least 90% RRT Credentialing Success. CoARC views the RRT credential as a standard of professional achievement and a measure

of a program's success in inspiring its graduates to achieve their highest educational and professional aspirations.

Recognized programs were required to meet the following rigorous criteria standards of the CoARC Board: (1) have three or more years of outcomes data; (2) hold accreditation without a progress report at the end of the year; (3) document RRT credentialing success of 90% or above, and (4) meet or exceed established CoARC thresholds for TMC high cut score and retention.

The CoARC Awards ceremony will be held on July 14 at the Fort Lauderdale Marriott Harbor Beach Resort & Spa in Fort Lauderdale, FL.
