Registration:

• **Registration on line for classes began in mid-June.** You are responsible to register for your own classes. The class schedule is available at <u>www.orangecoastcollege.edu</u>

Division Office:

Estimated Expenses:

- **\$46/unit** Tuition for California residents is currently at \$46/unit.
- **\$80** College fees (health, college service & parking) for fall and spring semester
- (varies) Class Fees: some lab classes have material fees, refer to the class schedule
- \$81 Background/Drug Screen Check Certificate
- \$21 Student Clinical Liability Insurance
- **\$50 \$100** Pre-Clinical physical exam and TB clearance
- \$300 Hepatitis B vaccine (required by Dental Assisting, Medical Assisting, Radiologic Technology and Respiratory Care and highly recommended for all other programs)
- (varies) Textbooks, uniforms and supplies: Cost varies by program. Textbooks will be available at the college bookstore about a week before the semester starts. Supplies and uniforms required will be announced in class by program coordinators.

Medical Exam:

You may complete your <u>Medical History and Physical Examination Form</u> either at your regular physician's office or at the OCC Student Health Center. If you are unable to download the medical form from the above link you can also download the form from our website at <u>OCC Allied Health Web Page and then click the Manuals and</u> <u>Forms Tab. The OCC Student Health Center is now open Monday through Thursday 8:30 a.m. to 12:00</u> <u>noon and 1:30-4:00 p.m.</u> If you choose the OCC facility, the summer is the *best* time to complete your exam due to increased campus usage when fall semester begins. In many cases, this is the most convenient and costeffective option.

The exam process requires several visits to the Student Health Center—it *cannot* be completed in one day. Be sure to bring any available immunization records that you may have on your first visit to the Health Center. You do *not* need to be registered as a student this summer to use the Student Health Center for your Allied Health physical exam. Check the OCC Health Center website for information at

NOTES:

- **Rad Tech** and **Dental** students will need to complete their physicals as soon as possible as they begin clinical training during the fall semester.
- **PSG** students should NOT start the Medical Exam at this time and should wait to be instructed by their program director.
- **DO NOT** send your medical records to the Division office. Your program coordinator will collect them and give you any additional program specific instructions.
