The Science & Engineering Tutoring Center (SETC) offers scheduled tutoring appointments both online and on campus as well as study skills workshops, course specific study groups, and drop-in tutoring for Science, Engineering, and Computer Science courses. Students can make appointments with tutors via Accudemia (from within the TUTOR 050N Canvas) or by coming into the Center. Getting Started:

- All students must be registered in TUTOR 050N to receive tutoring. (10265)
- Once enrolled, students can request a tutoring session by logging in to Canvas and selecting the TUTOR 050N course. Within the TUTOR 050N Canvas there are modules for each tutoring area. Select Science & Engineering to access appointments for the SETC. Appointments can be scheduled via Accudemia or in person. Contact the SETC if you have any questions or problems.
- You are limited to 1 appointment per subject a day, with a maximum of two appointments per subject per week. You may book up to 4 hours of tutoring per week. There is no limit on drop-in tutoring hours.
- Please be respectful of others' sensitivity to strong scents, odors, and sounds.
- Rude, inconsiderate behavior/language toward staff or other students will not be tolerated and may result in disciplinary action.
- Review the Cancellation and No-Show policy posted in Canvas so you can keep your ability to schedule tutoring appointments

Who are my tutors?

SETC tutors must meet academic criteria, be recommended by an instructor, and complete tutor training. Our staff of tutors is a diverse group of OCC students, former OCC students who are now at local universities, and graduates with degrees.

Please come prepared in order to maximize your time spent with the tutor.

- Have your book, syllabus, lecture notes, and study materials available
- Have questions ready to ask the tutor if you have an appointment
- Come ready to work

Tutors Will:

- Help you understand the material
- Help with study skills, such as test prep, note taking, and time management
- Encourage and support your efforts to learn

Tutors Will Not:

- Do your homework for you
- Just give you the answers
- Help with take-home or on-line quizzes and exams





Math Center:

Science & Engineering Tutoring:
