- **<u>I.</u> Call to Order:** President Sachs called the meeting to order at 12:34 PM.
- <u>II.</u> Approval of the Minutes: *Motion 1: Parliamentarian Sachs moved* to approve the February 23, 2021, minutes; motion seconded; approved unanimously.
- III. Executive Board Members Reports: The E-Board discussed the minutes, confidentiality, and the Brown Act; Secretary Kennedy was charged with contacting the District with questions regarding those issues. PDI Chair Kennedy said that depending on the hours, there may be some funding available from PDI for Curriculum Committee members who would like to take the class.
