- D. **Executive Board Member Reports:**

President Drew reported that because the OCC President requested and obtained eight new full-time faculty positions to be hired, he will not need to forward his written request to her to hire more full-time faculty.

Vice-President Gordon restated from the Senate meeting that the February 17, 2026, Senate meeting will be run by the part-time senators and will cover part-time issues.

Secretary Kennedy stated that while the GWC and Coastline Senate bylaws are indeed different than OCC's, those colleges have historically been less effective than OCC in advocating for the faculty and keeping the faculty's voice separate from their administrators. She noted the difference in their IPD/PDI structures and their issues at the other two colleges as one of many examples she was familiar with.

The E-Board discussed getting the OER Coordinator on the Senate agenda before the change in the laws.
