1. **President's Report** – Jasmine Nguyen:

A. President - Jasmine Nguyen: Thanked Senator Rangno for leading the last meeting on February, 23.

- Chancellor's Search Committee: Classified Senates across the District were able to earn one seat in the Chancellor's Search Committee. This representative would represent all three collages. OCC needs to make a nomination for a candidate. There is a meeting next week so we need to move quickly. President Nguyen open floor nominations. She nominated Senator Rangno because of her experience. Goldenwest President Tim McGrath is leading the search committee.
 - 1. In meeting Nomination and across district Selection process
 - 1. Since we need to work very rapidly to add a Classified representative onto the hiring committee, we need to establish how we would like to select our nominee for the rep.

 - 3. Submit for representation among the Senate presidents

 - 1. HEDS Quantitative
 - 2. Focus Group Qualitative
 - 3. This has been a very long process.

4. Elections

- 1. President-Elect nominations will open first week of March to all Classified Professionals.
 - 1. Tri-President Model will help support the transition of the new president into their role of Classified Senate President
 - 2. Nominees will have the opportunity to accept or decline their nomination
 - 3. Elections is scheduled to be held March 14 March 18
 - 4. The President must be nominated from the current slate of Senators. You do get release time for this position. E-board gets 40 hours of release time, collectively. The release time is now on the contract.
