



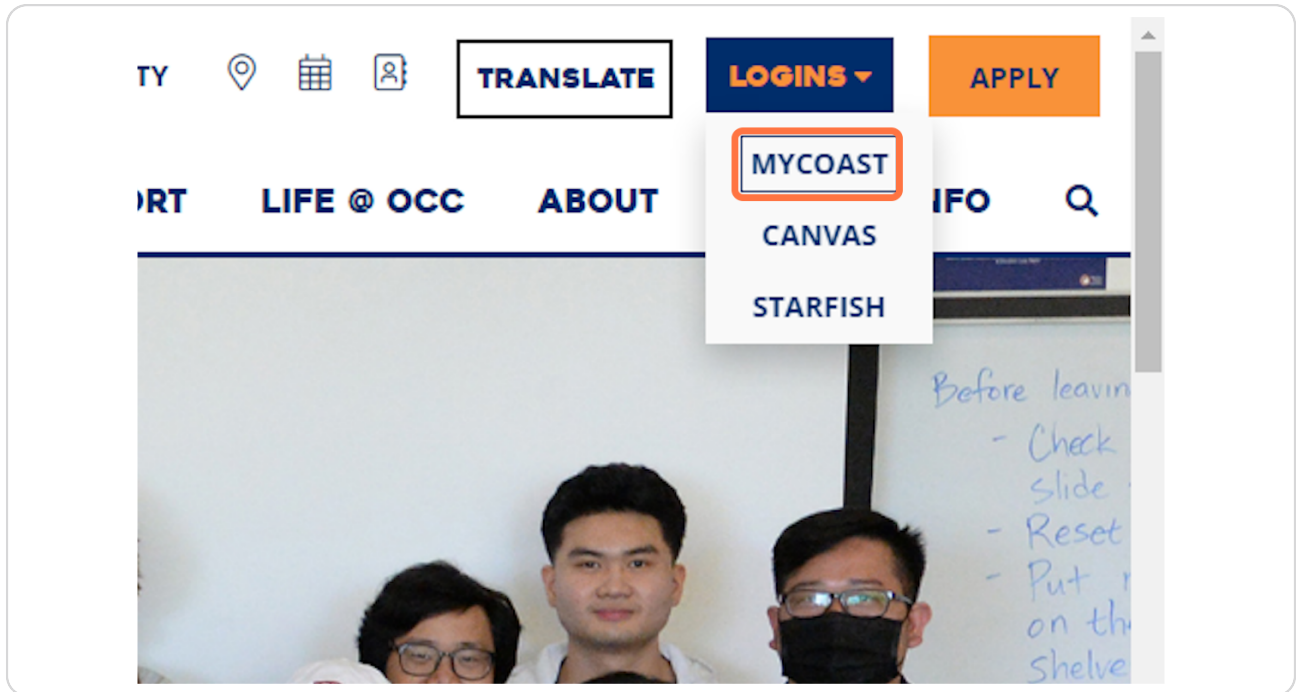
GUIDE FOR LOGGING INTO YOUR MYCOAST STUDENT PORTAL

STEP 1

[Go to orangecoastcollege.edu](http://orangecoastcollege.edu)

STEP 2

Click on "MYCOAST" on the top right corner of the website to open the login page.



STEP 3

Type "username@student.cccd.edu"

A welcome email is sent to your email address used on the OCC Application. The email will have your **OCC student ID number**, **username**, **student email** and **temporary password**. If you do not see this email, please check your Spam, Junk, Trash, or Deleted folders. If you can not locate the email contact us at fpr@occ.cccd.edu.

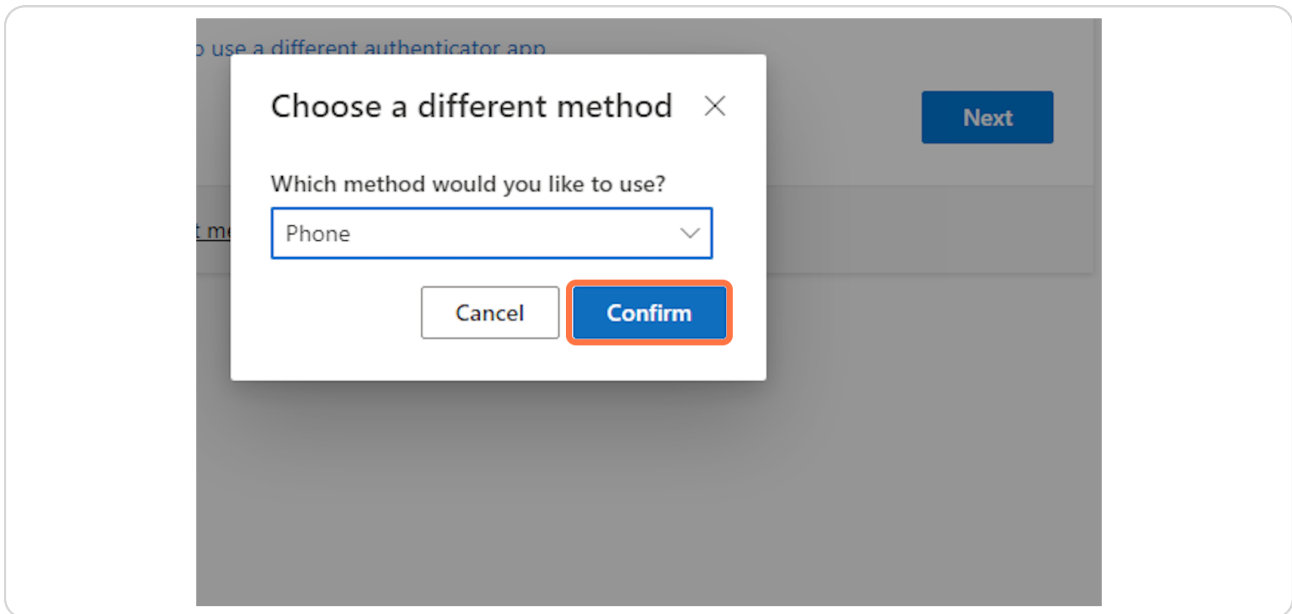
Click on "I want to set up a different method". DO NOT DOWNLOAD THE APP!

STEP 9


Click on "Phone" in the drop down menu. Then click "Confirm".

Type in your phone number, and select "Text me a code" or "Call me". Then click "Next".


Make sure you have your phone handy, a code will be sent to you.

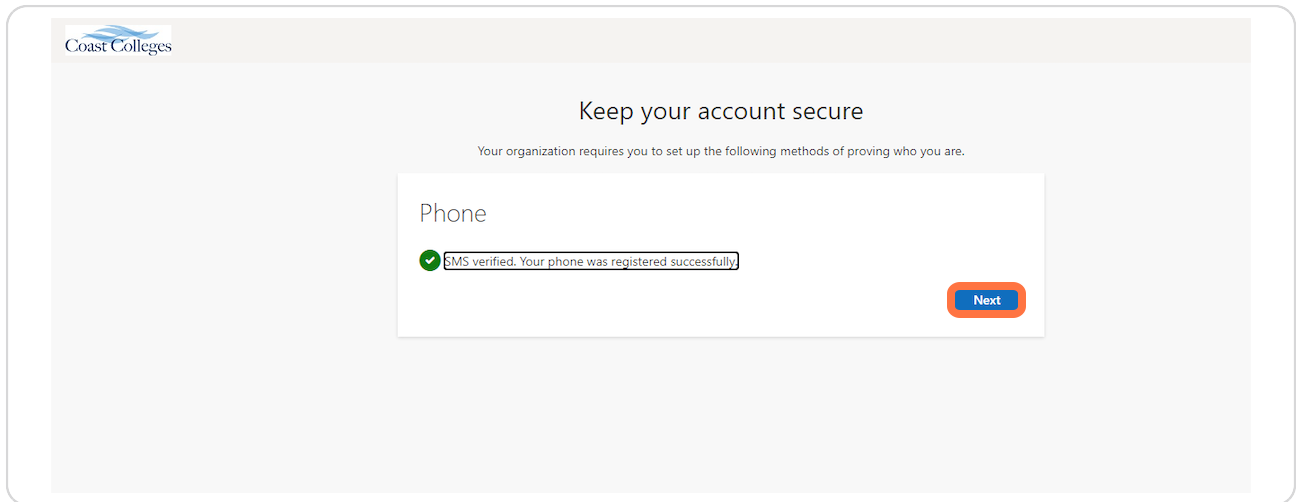
Once you enter the code, click "Next".

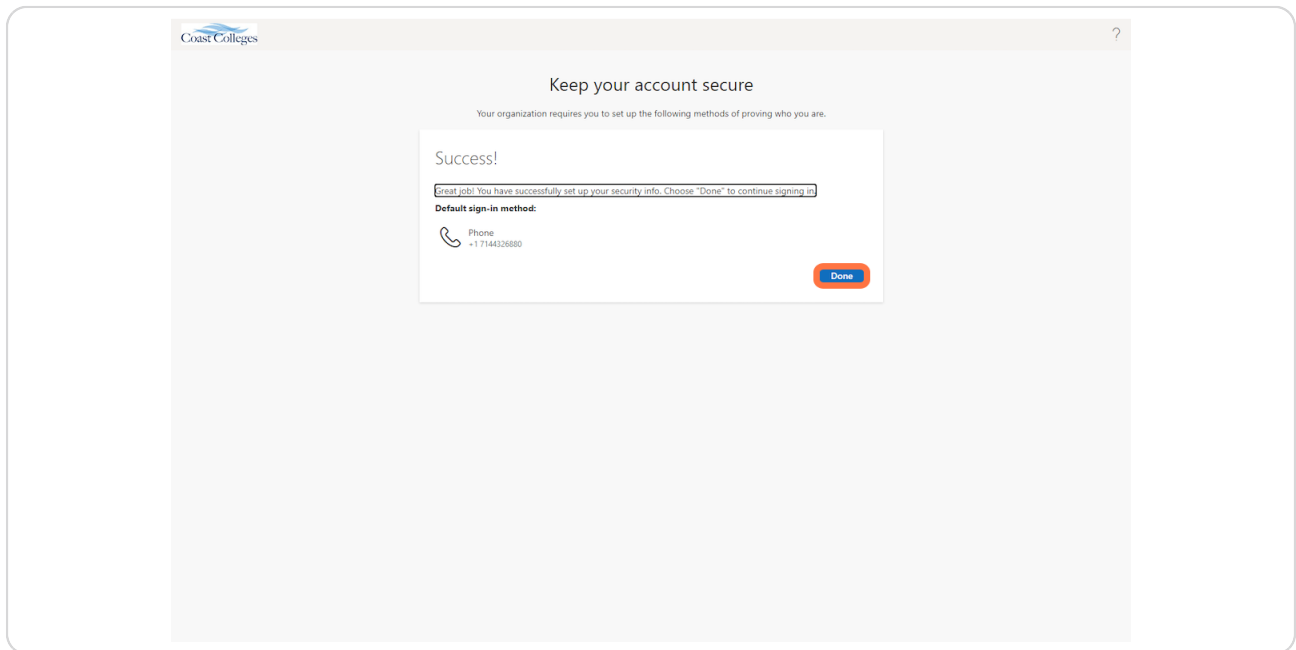
STEP 12
