### **SGOCC Policy 2001: Student Senate Election Policy Proposed Revision**

#### **Part 2: Administrative**

##### **SGOCC Policy 2001: Student Senate Election Policy**

- 1) The rules set forth in this Election Code shall be enforced by the ASOCC Director of Student Life for all Student Senate elections and this code shall apply to all elections.
- 2) All prospective Student Senate candidates shall meet the minimum qualifications as outlined in the SGOCC Bylaws at the time of application and throughout their prospective term of office.
- 3) Each candidate for elective office shall submit a completed application to the ASOCC Director of Student Life by the date set forth in the Senator Application packet.
  - 3-a) If there are an insufficient number of candidates (i.e., there are less applicants than there are open Student Senate seats), the initial application deadline will be extended for 7 calendar days.
