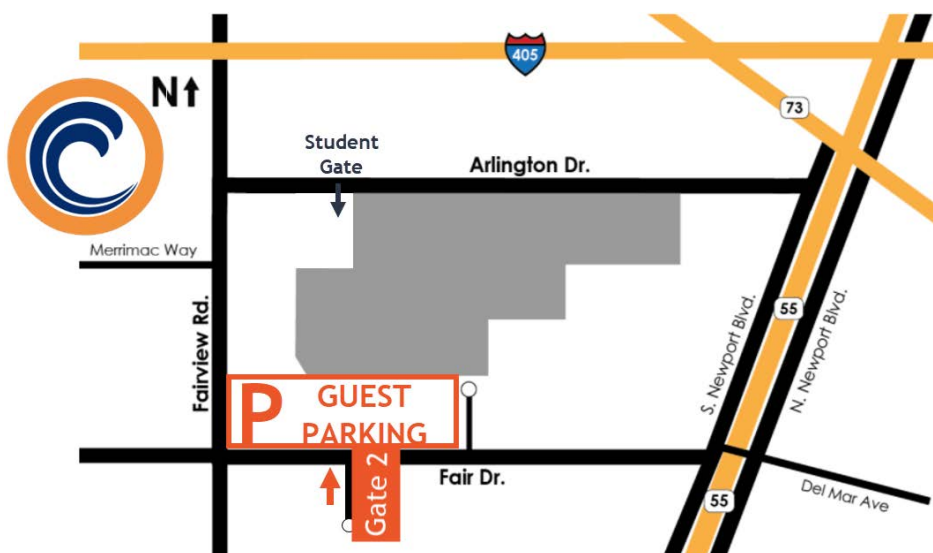

- **Parking.** Guest parking is available from Gates 2 or 3 in Lots B, C and D.
- **Attire.** Comfortable shoes are highly recommended due to stairs inside the Amphitheatre. Temperatures fluctuate, so dressing in layers is advisable.
- **Flowers.** On-site sales of flower bouquets and leis will be available before the ceremony. You may also visit our website to pre-order bouquets, orchid leis, alumni gifts, or other graduate essentials.
- **Arrive Early.** Seating begins at 4:15 p.m. and is on a first-come, first-served basis. Plan to arrive at least 30 minutes before the ceremony start time for seating.
- **Ceremony.** The ceremony will start at 5:30 p.m. and lasts ~ 2 hours. Please allow an additional 20-40 minutes for the post-event reception and to exit the parking area.
- **Meet Up with Graduates.** After the recessional out of the Amphitheatre, plan to reunite with your grad and meet distinguished faculty at the post-event reception.
- **Accessibility.** The amphitheatre is wheelchair accessible. A special seating area is reserved for guests with disabilities and one accompanying family member each. Accessible parking will be available in Lot B (Gate 2).
