

# UC Transfer Application Checklist

## Minimum Requirements for Upper Division Transfer Admissions Eligibility:

- ☐ **Complete 60 UC-transferable units** by the end of the prior Spring semester for Fall transfer. Check [www.assist.org](http://www.assist.org) for UC transferability of CA community college coursework.
- ☐ **Earn a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.40** in all UC transferable coursework (2.80 for non-residents).  
\*Some majors/campuses may require a higher GPA for major admissions selection.
- ☐ **Complete minimum major preparation:** review [www.assist.org](http://www.assist.org) and each campus-specific website to identify specific major preparation courses required or recommended by each campus.
- ☐ **Complete general education:** Complete either the “[7-Course Pattern](#)” , full IGETC (Option 3) pattern OR full Cal-GETC pattern.

## Additional Recommendations

- ☐ **Meet with a counselor** for educational planning to prepare for an appropriate transfer timeline.
- ☐ Visit each individual **UC Campus Transfer Admissions, Department, and Major websites** for minimum transfer admissions requirements and application steps unique to that campus, including the deadlines by which all minimum preparation must be completed.
- ☐ **Check if the major is selective.** Campuses with selective majors receive more applicants than they can accommodate and will utilize supplemental criteria in the admissions process, such as specific minimum major preparation or increased minimum GPA.
- ☐ Learn about [UC Transfer Admission Guarantee \(TAG\)](#) or [OCC Honors Program](#).
- ☐ Create an account on [UC Transfer Admission Planner \(TAP\)](#) to track your progress towards UC transfer.

## Fall Application Process\*

Fall	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><input type="checkbox"/> If eligible, <b>submit a TAG application</b> during the September 1-30<sup>th</sup> filing period using <a href="#">UC Transfer Admission Planner (TAP)</a>.</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> <b>Complete the UC Application</b> – opens August 1<sup>st</sup>; submit between October 1<sup>st</sup>-November 30<sup>th</sup> for fall applicants. Attend <a href="#">UC Application workshops/open labs</a> and <a href="#">drop-in hours</a> for <a href="#">application assistance</a>.</li></ul>
Winter	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><input type="checkbox"/> <b>Application Follow-up:</b> All campuses require students to submit a “<a href="#">Transfer Academic Update</a>” (TAU) in January. Some majors request additional documentation or other updates. Follow instructions and deadlines provided by each campus.</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> If earning a degree from OCC, file a <b>Petition for Graduation</b> through <a href="#">the Graduation Office</a>. Students pursuing an AD-T must petition by February 15<sup>th</sup>.</li></ul>
Spring	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><input type="checkbox"/> Hear back from UCs via email about your admission status.</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> If accepted, submit your <b>Statement of Intent to Register (SIR)</b> to one UC campus by their SIR deadline.</li></ul>
Summer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><input type="checkbox"/> <b>Order your official transcripts and general education certification</b> (i.e. IGETC, or Cal-GETC) be sent to your UC campus by designated deadlines. <a href="#">Order Transcripts</a> under “My Records” tab on MyCoast portal.</li></ul>

*\*Most UC campus are limited to fall transfer. However, some may offer spring or winter transfer. Check the UC website for more information.*
