



UC Fall Application After You Apply – Next Steps

Already submitted your UC application? Here are some important next steps:



- 1** You will be asked to **update your Fall grades** online after the semester is over. Keep an eye out for an email, and be sure to submit grades by the deadline given. *
- 2** Keep an eye out for **admission decisions**. These are made between February and April with most students hearing back in March/April.
- 3** Once you're admitted, submit your **Statement of Intent to Register (SIR)**, and pay the deposit by June 1. *
- 4** Send your **final official transcripts** to the campus you will be attending in Fall. When you order them, be sure to **mark the IGETC certification box**. Submit transcripts from every college you've attended and AP/IB scores if applicable. *

* Missing these deadlines can result in your application not being considered for admission, or if you miss the deadline after you've been admitted, your acceptance can be rescinded. **PAY ATTENTION TO DEADLINES.**

What else should I do?

OCC Graduation

Will you be completing an Associate's degree at OCC?

- Submit a **petition to graduate** between January 4th and March 1st on MyOCC. Students completing an ADT should submit in January.

- Attend **commencement** in May (Optional).

Campus Housing

Will you be relocating when you transfer and need housing?

- Check the website of the UC campus you will be attending for **on-campus and off-campus housing** opportunities.

Financial Support

- To apply for **state and federal aid** (grants & loans), complete the FAFSA application by the priority deadline on March 2nd.

- AB 540 students: complete the California Dream Act application by March 2nd.

- Apply for transfer **scholarships** through the OCC scholarship office.
