YOUR PROGRAM INCLUDES:

- One-time airport transfer from Seoul (ICN) airport to accommodation and return on program arrival and end dates.
- Accommodation in a student residence in single or double studio rooms with small kitchen and laundry facilities. Bed linens, towels & Wi-Fi provided.
- Meals: self-catering facilities at student accommodation, a welcome event, a farewell dinner, and occasional meals on excursions.
- Travel pass: a smart card pre-loaded with funds valid for travel on all trains and trams, subways and buses in the Seoul metropolitan area.
- Orientation and local-area tour.
- Guided sightseeing tour of Seoul.
- A full-day excursion to the DMZ including transportation, guided visits to the Gamaksan Bridge, the Third Tunnel and the Dora Observatory.
- A guided tour of Gyeongbokgung Palace.
- A full-day excursion to a traditional Korean Village including transportation, guided tour and craft demonstrations.
- A Korean cooking class.
- A 2-day, 1-night excursion to Busan including transportation by train, hotel with breakfast basis and a guided walking tour.
- Support services, medical insurance, 24-hour emergency contact service, travel arrangements, and student advisors provided by AIFS.
