The Orange Coast College Foundation's goal is to help ensure access to textbooks for as many students as possible. A lending library has been established in the OCC Library through which textbooks for the "Top 100" classes at OCC are available for use in the library for 2 hours at a time. If your textbook is not already in the library, the library staff will make every effort to acquire your textbook.

Saturday 10am to 3pm (Sat hours subject to change)

Up to \$300 can be made available through a Bookstore Account for the Fall and Spring terms only.
